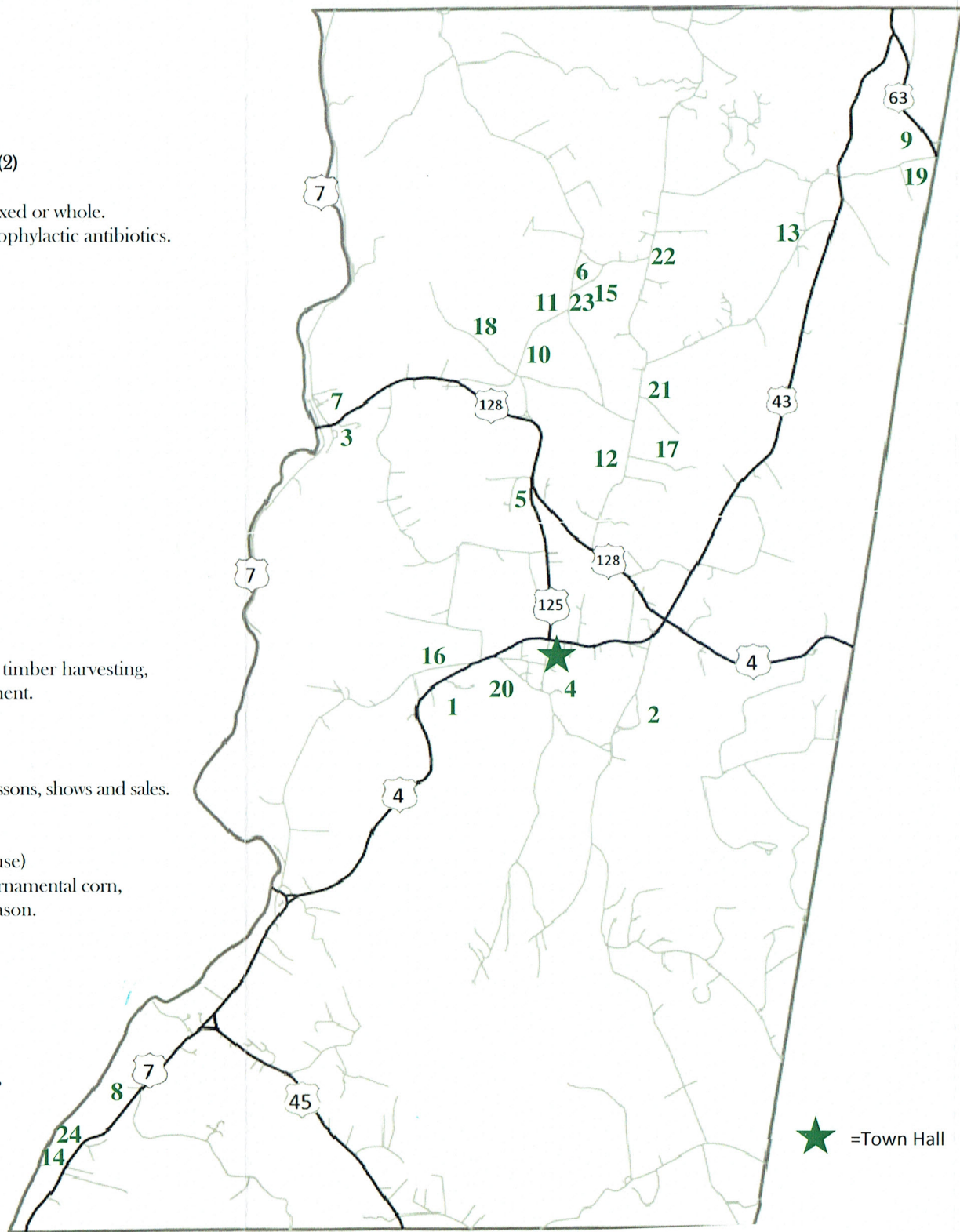
Conventional food in the U.S. typically travels 1500 to 2000 miles. And at any given meal, we will have ingredients from at least 5 different countries.
